Eligibility Requirements

Public Partner

- There are no eligibility requirements to be a public partner
- Recommend completing the Registration Form

Bronze Star Partner

- Complete Partner Application form
- Conduct background checks through the KBI or FBI as well as sex offender registry for all mentors, volunteers and staff
- Have a valid Employer Identification Number (EIN)
- Carry liability insurance

Silver Star Partner

- Complete Tier 1 requirements
- Conduct Child Abuse and Neglect Central Registry check for all mentors, volunteers and staff
- Register on the Mentor Connector free online database
- Align to the Elements of Effective Practice for Mentoring (EPPM Standards)

Gold Star Partner

- Complete Tier 1 & 2 requirements
- Complete the National Quality Mentoring System (NQMS) self-assessment
- Complete and maintain customized Innovation and Improvement Plan to demonstrate that the Elements of Effective Practice for Mentoring are met and being implemented correctly

Programs must align to Mentor Kansas' definition of mentoring:
A consistent, structured, stable relationship between youth and a caring role model(s) that involves regular, ongoing and ideally face-to-face meetings; and is focused on developing the character, capabilities and confidence of the young person(s).
